Deadline: E-Mailed (preferred) or Postmarked no later than **Friday, June 28th, 2024.**

Scholarship Award: One (non-renewable) scholarship for one academic year. Minimum award amount of \$1,000 per winner. Higher amounts may be awarded at the discretion of the Board based on funding availability.

Degree Program: Registered as a full-time student in an undergraduate (Sophomore/Junior/Senior level) or postgraduate STEM (Science, Technology, Engineering, Mathematics) program at an accredited university. Preference will be given to applicants enrolled in at least one Traffic/Transportation Engineering or Transportation Planning related class.
